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## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

## 1. Announcement

Ecurie Royal Oak Motor Club Ltd will organise an Interclub Navigational Rally on the 9th \& 10th September 2023. The event will start and finish at The Knot Inn, Rushton Spencer (Map ref 118/935 624)

## 2. Jurisdiction

The event will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), by these Supplementary Regulations and by any other written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

## 3. Authorisation

Motorsport UK Permit number 132400.
Authorisation for the event to take place on the public highway will be displayed on the official event notice board.
4. Eligibility

The event is open to:
a) All members of the organising club
b) Members of the clubs of the following associations: ANWCC, EMAMC, ANCC \& WAMC North

## 5. Championships

The event is a round of the Road \& Navigational Rally Championship of the following Regional Associations : ANWCC \& EMAMC

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8. Route

- Map numbers 118 and 119 latest editions are required.
- Total mileage will be approximately 130 Miles, including approx. 7 miles of smooth unsurfaced roads. Whilst the unsurfaced roads are largely smooth, a sump guard and knobbly tyres are recommended for the more competitive crews.
- Any private roads used have the prior consent of the owners.
- The event will contain sections on the public road timed to an accuracy of less than one minute.

The following types of controls will be used:
RS/RF - Regularity Start/Finish Control
IRTC - Intermediate Regularity Control
NTC- Neutral Time Control
MTC- Main Time Control
Further information including procedure at each type of control will be detailed in the Final Instructions.

## 9. Classes

The Event will consist of three classes, as follows:
EXPERT - Where either member has finished in the top 10 on at least 3 occasions since 2013.
SEMI EXPERT - A crew where either member has finished in the top 10 since 2013 and is not eligible for Expert.
NOVICE- A crew which is not eligible for Expert or Semi-Expert.
Previous results should be for crews in the role as entered for this event and for National B or Interclub rallies.

## 10. Additional Technical Regulations

As the event uses sections on private land, competitors are reminded it is a requirement to carry a small spill kit as per R.18.6.5. This will be checked at scrutineering. Remember that a red warning triangle must be carried at all times, this along with a valid MOT certificate will be checked at scrutineering.

IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING NOISE: All cars will be subject to a noise test conducted by the environmental scrutineer. Noise limits will be strictly administered due to concerns by the Staffordshire Constabulary and residents along the route.

## 12. Entries

- Entries open $23^{\text {rd }}$ July and close at 23:59 on $26^{\text {th }}$ August..
- Entry fee is $£ 120.00$, and this includes quality breakfast at the finish.
- Entries must be made using the online system via MTC1.uk.
- The maximum entry for this meeting is 45 .
- The minimum entry for this meeting is 30 .
(Should these figures not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event)
- Entries will be on a first come first serve basis once fully paid and completed.
- Should 45 paid entries be received, any subsequent entries shall be placed on a reserve list.
- Cancellation of an entry before $2^{\text {nd }}$ September will result in a full refund. (Subject to a $£ 20$ administration fee).
- Cancellation after this date may be refunded at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course (subject to a $£ 20$ administration fee).


## 13. Results

Provisional results will be published on-line at MTC1. uk within 2 hours of the last car completing the event. Following this, there will be a period for competitors to raise any queries, protests or appeals. The exact time for this will be confirmed in the Final Instructions. Any protests or appeals must be lodged in accordance with C 5.1 to 5.7. Results will be final once all matters have been settled.

## 14. Route Information

Competitors will be supplied with timecards, black-spots and re-join points at Documentation. Route instructions will be issued at MTC0 and at various points along the route per R9.1 and R14.1.

Route instructions will be straightforward and it should not be necessary to plot on the move or in competitive sections. These documents will provide all the information necessary to enable competitors to comply with R2.3.2.

Competitors will be required to make up as much lateness as possible on specified time make-up sections. Maximum time make-up will be identified on the timecards.

## 15. Identification

Competitors will be provided with two rally plates (supplied by CN Signs Ltd) which must be displayed:

1. On or just below the rear near-side window.
2. On the rear window.

Rally Plates must be removed once the vehicle has retired from or completed the event per R.6.1

## 16. Penalties

Marking and penalties will be applied as per R. 13 using the 'Time' System. The following shall also apply:

| Altering Time Card | Disqualification |

| Conveying route to spectators | Disqualification |
| Use of mobile devices for unfairly obtaining route information or advantage | Disqualification |
| Entering a "Blackspot" or passing a "NO" board | Disqualification |
| Adverse report from Judges of Fact \& DSOs in relation to R24.7-24.9 | Disqualification |
| Not complying with R9.1.5 and R9.1.6 | Disqualification |
| Failure to follow instructions of an official R13(r) | Disqualification |
| R10.3.1 Use of auxiliary lights in Neutral sections or other "Quiet" sections <br> notified in the route instructions | Disqualification |
| Jump start | 30 seconds |
| Striking a cone or marker on private land sections | 30 seconds |
| Failure to stop at control board | 1 minute |

OTL may be reduced from 30 minutes (but not lower than 15 minutes).

## 17. Control Procedure

At all manned controls after MTC1 cars must stop at the control board, dip the headlights, and proceed to the marshal carefully. Failure to comply will result in a 1-minute penalty being applied by that marshal. The time given at all time controls will be when the car stops at the control board.

## 18. Modification of General Regulations

All other General Regulations of the MSUK apply as written, except for the following, which are modified: R2.3.3 Secret checks may be established to ensure compliance with route instructions, technical regulations, noise and maps used. R7.2.3 Mobile telephones may be carried in the car (for use in breakdown or emergency situations only). R15.2.2 In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by the furthest cleanest then lowest engine capacity.


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## 19. Insurance

Vehicles must have Insurance in place which provides as a minimum, Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act. This can be either, by extending an existing motor policy to cover the event, or, by purchasing additional cover as an adjunct to an existing motor policy.

If a competitor uses an extension to an existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the cover complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor.

If a competitor wishes to purchase additional cover via the organisers, then they can do so prior to the event providing they comply with the following:

- Age 19 years or over
- Has held a full licence for a minimum of 6 months
- Has no more than 6 points on their licence
- Has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years
- The vehicle must hold a valid MOT Cert, current road insurance, and Road Tax, unless exempt from doing so.
- All competitors MUST be a named driver on the road insurance

Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family or over 25 .

Any competitor who falls outside these parameters may be offered cover at equivalent terms or an agreed price, if approval from Reis Motorsport Insurance has been obtained by the event organisers, prior to the event.

Additional cover provided by this scheme is only effective whilst the vehicle is actively competing in the event and remains under the control or direction of the event organiser(s). Cover will cease immediately if you are precluded, excluded, or retire from the event.

The Event Organiser's RTA scheme is provided by Reis Motorsport Insurance and underwritten by Markerstudy Insurance Services Limited. The set amount for this insurance cover is $\mathbf{£ 2 9 . 0 0}$ for the event which can selected and paid for via MTC1.uk entries system.

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## 20. Other Information

- Signing-on will be electronic using a MTC1.uk form, competitors will receive an e-mail reminder containing a link to do this. You will be required to upload images of your MSUK Interclub License and Club Card.
- Ecurie Royal Oak membership is available on the night or email interest to eromembership@hotmail.co.uk
- Petrol is available at halfway (approx. 60 miles).
- Organiser's mileages shall be deemed correct and not subject to protest.
- Force majeure notwithstanding, the Organisers reserve the right to delete or amend penalties at any control or check and/or delete any part of the route from results, should they deem it fairer to do so. (This will be enforced where it is obvious that a competitor has an incorrect time recorded on his/her timecard.)
- Any notice displayed on the official notice board or on the route bearing an official's signature shall have the same authority as these SRs.
- A digital souvenir image taken by the event photographer M\&H Photography is included in the entry fee. Your email details will be forwarded to the Photographer for this purpose.
- Competitors are reminded of Section 170 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 of the Highway Code: Any injury incidents must be reported to the relevant Police Authority.
- This is not a spectator event, and no spectator information will be issued, any competitor found to be sharing route information with non-competitors will be excluded from the event.
- Code boards must be recorded in ink and be signed for at the next manned time control.


## 21. Navigation

All navigation instructions will be clear and easy to plot. We aim to run an event that will be enjoyable for both crew members, we will not be using any tricks or trying to catch crews out.
